this study is a scholarly biography of one of france s foremost political leaders in a career which ran from the 1880s to the 1930s one of the most formative periods of modern french history poincaré held the principal offices of state he played crucial roles in france s entry into the great war the organisation of the war effort the peace settlement the reparations question the occupation of the ruhr and the reorganisation of french finances in the 1920s his life and work is surrounded by controversy and myth from poincaré la guerre to poincaré le franc which this book dissects using a host of new archival material professor keiger explores the historiography of the man and his times and reveals somewhat surprisingly how animal rights and feminism could be as important to him as party politics and public finance

who were the senior generals who took france through the first world war and why do we know so little about them they commanded the largest force on the western front through both humiliating defeats and forgotten victories they won international respect and adoration but also led their army to infamous mutiny nevertheless the french and their allies under a french general in chief would eventually achieve final victory over imperial germany it is extraordinary that this remarkable group of men has been so neglected in histories on the war previous studies are outdated and haven t tapped the wealth of primary source material in france s military archives it is this gap in the literature and in the understanding of the conflict that this thought provoking and original volume is designed to address it takes a collective biographical approach to the leading french soldiers who ran the war on the western front

a century ago general joffre as chief of the french general staff led the armies that blocked the german invasion at the first battle of the marne he saved paris from occupation and france from probable defeat his calm demeanour when faced with a disaster his ruthless dismissal of incompetent subordinates and his skilled redeployment of his forces contributed to a historic victory at the time many saw him as the saviour of the nation but what should we make of him now for joffre contributed to the failures of the french army and its strategy before the war and during the first battles of 1914 also his conduct of the war after the marne futile offensives that cost thousands of lives and gained no ground followed by near defeat at verdun undermined his position and led to his dismissal although he remained immensely popular in france his reputation has been under a cloud ever since and he has been overshadowed by the french generals ptain and especially foch who commanded the french army at the time of the final victory over germany andr bourachot in this lucid and highly readable study of joffre s career focuses on his performance during the opening phase of the great war he offers a fresh and carefully considered view of the man and the soldier

the origins of the first world war remain one of the greatest twentieth century historical controversies in this debate the role of military planning in particular and of militarism in general are a key focus of attention did the military wrest control from the civilians were the leaders of europe eager for a conflict what military commitments were made between the various alliance blocks these questions are examined in detail here in eleven essays by distinguished historians and the editor s introduction provides a focus and draws out the comparative approach to the history of military policies and war plans of the great powers

histories of the first world war are often written from a british perspective ignoring the coalition element of the conflict and the french point of view in strategy and command roy prete offers a major new interpretation supported by in depth research in french archival sources in the first of three projected volumes prete crafts a behind the scenes look at anglo french command relations during world war i from the start of the conflict until 1915 when trench warfare drastically altered the situation drawing on extensive archival research prete argues that the british government s primary interest lay in the defence of the empire the small expeditionary force sent to france was progressively enlarged because the french especially commander in chief joseph joffre dragged their british ally into a progressively greater involvement several crises in anglo french command relations derived from these competing strategic objectives new information gleaned from french public and private archives including private diaries enlarge our understanding of key players in the allied relationship prete shows that suspicion and distrust on the part of both sides of the alliance continued to inform relations well after the circumstances creating them had changed strategy and command clearly establishes the fundamental strategic differences between the allies at the start of the war setting the stage for the next two volumes
